Please Take Notice: The Joint Drainage Authority for Le Sueur and Rice Counties (“Drainage Authority”), as the Drainage Authority for Le Sueur – Rice Counties Joint Ditch No. 63 (“JD 63”) will hold a final hearing on the redetermination of benefits for JD 63. The viewers’ report for the redetermination of benefits was filed with the Drainage Authority on October 23, 2018. The report is available for inspection at the Le Sueur County Auditor-Treasurer’s office in the Le Sueur County Courthouse, 88 South Park Avenue, Le Center, Minnesota or by contacting the Le Sueur County Auditor-Treasurer’s Office at (507) 357-8282. The hearing will be held on November 29, 2018, at 9:30 a.m. in the Commissioners’ Room at the Le Sueur County Courthouse, 88 South Park Avenue, Le Center, Minnesota. The Drainage Authority will accept public comment regarding the proposed viewers’ report. Any party having an interest in the proceedings may appear and provide comment. Written comments will be accepted at the hearing and by mail, through the date of the hearing, at the Drainage Authority’s mailing address.

JD 63 provides drainage to portions of Sections 1, 2, & 3 in Kilkenny Township (110N-23W) and Sections 24, 25, 26, 34, 35, & 36 in Montgomery Township (111N-23W) in Le Sueur County and to portions of Sections 18, 19, 20, 30, & 31, of Erin Township (111N-22W) and Section 6 in Shieldsville Township (110N-22W) in Rice County.
