Conditional Use Permit Specific Use Form

Grading, Excavating or Filling for Shoreland: _____ **Permit #**

A. Grading, excavating, or filling of 50 cubic yards or more for one project, and/or 10 cubic yards or more in a shore impact zone, including but not limited to, landscaping, excavation for wildlife habitat, excavation and preparation for building and similar activity, land improvement shall require a Conditional Use Permit.

B. Minimum Standards:

1. Erosion control measures shall be required.
2. Excavation shall not take place within 50 feet of a property line.
3. Grading and filling in any type of wetland must be evaluated in accordance with the Minnesota Wetland Conservation Act.
4. Any project within a Shoreland District shall conform to the provisions of Section 13.

C. Specific Use Form: The Specific Use Form for Grading Excavating or Filling must accompany the Conditional Use Permit application, as well as any supporting documentation listed on the application *and* listed below:

- _____ 1. Site plan showing the location of grading, excavation or filling sites, location of any areas for obtaining fill or for disposing of excavated materials.
- _____ 3. A cross section sketch of the proposed work.
- _____ 4. Erosion control plan.
- _____ 5. Final grading and drainage plan.
- _____ 6. Restoration plan (*see below*).
- _____ 7. Performance securities and insurance for projects of more than 1500 cubic yards.

D. Restoration Plan: All permits shall contain a restoration plan providing for the use of the land after project completion. The following are minimum standards for restoration:

1. All disturbed areas shall be restored at the completion of the project.
2. All restoration shall include the application of a minimum of 4 inches of topsoil or similar material that will support plant growth.
3. Grading Standards:
 - a. Final grades shall be in conformity with the topography of the surrounding land.
 - b. If the land is to be restored to crop production, no slope shall exceed 20% (5:1).
 - c. If the restoration is not for crop production, no grade shall exceed 33% (3:1).
4. All restored areas shall be seeded with a mixture recommended by the Soil Conservation Service or returned to crop production
5. Reforestation may be required and shall be based on the recommendation of the Soil Conservation Service and/or the Department of Natural Resources District Forester.
