

Le Sueur County Resolution
To Extend Le Sueur County Comprehensive
Local Water Management Plan

WHEREAS, Minnesota Statutes, 103B.301, Comprehensive Local Water Management Act, authorizes Minnesota Counties to develop and implement a Comprehensive Local Water Management Plan, and

WHEREAS, Le Sueur County currently has a state approved Comprehensive Local Water Management Plan that covers the period of September 6, 2016 through December 31, 2021, and

WHEREAS, an amendment to the Le Sueur County Comprehensive Local Water Management Plan was approved on September 6, 2016 and,

WHEREAS, Le Sueur County is actively participating in the Cannon River One Watershed, One Plan Process and,

WHEREAS, Le Sueur County will actively participate in the Lower Minnesota River One Watershed One Plan process once initiated and,

WHEREAS, Le Sueur County will actively participate in the Middle Minnesota River One Watershed One Plan process once initiated and,

WHEREAS, Le Sueur County adopted a resolution on April 21, 2020 that supported a planning grant to develop a comprehensive watershed management plan for the Le Sueur River Watershed, but Le Sueur County will opt out of all planning efforts due to the limited areas within the watershed; and

WHEREAS, the Minnesota Board of Water and Soil Resources has authorization to grant extensions pursuant to Minnesota Statutes 103B.3367;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, The Le Sueur County Board of Commissioners requests from the Minnesota Board of Water and Soil Resources an extension of the effective date of the current County Comprehensive Local Water Management Plan until December 31, 2026, in order to complete the update process in accordance with Minnesota Statutes 103B.301.
