

AGREEMENT

This Agreement is entered into by and between Le Sueur County, through its Emergency Management Department, and the City of Waterville.

I. PURPOSE

The purpose of this agreement is to delineate the conditions that have been mutually agreed upon by the parties regarding the transfer of a Rehab Unit trailer from Le Sueur County Emergency Management to the City of Waterville.

II. BACKGROUND

Le Sueur County Emergency Management received a Rehab Unit trailer from the Division of Homeland Security & Emergency Management through a federal grant from the Office of Domestic Preparedness during FY 2003. The trailer is designed to respond to a wide array of situations to include: weapons of mass destruction events, hazardous materials emergencies, or agriculture disasters. Designed to work on the edge of the hot zone, the trailer is a practical addition to any municipality. Le Sueur County Emergency Management is no longer using the Rehab Unit trailer on a regular basis and desires to give it to the City of Waterville.

III. AGREEMENTS

A. Le Sueur County Emergency Management

1. Agrees to transfer the Rehab Unit trailer as described: Year: 2004, VIN#1A9VELR2441247720, Model: MDT208, Make: ACSI to the City of Waterville.
2. Agrees to make the arrangements necessary for the delivery of the trailer to the City of Waterville.
3. Agrees to provide the City of Waterville with the Certificate of Title for the trailer.

B. City of Waterville

1. Agrees that the trailer is provided “as is”, with no warranty expressed or implied; and Le Sueur County assumes no liability for its fitness.
2. Agrees to coordinate with Le Sueur County Emergency Management the time and location for receiving delivery of the trailer.
3. Agrees to assume full responsibility for the storage of the trailer, and for all trailer maintenance and operating costs.
4. Agrees to assume full responsibility for licensing the trailer.
5. Agrees to use the trailer for a public, not private purpose.
6. Agrees to allow Le Sueur County Emergency Management the occasional use of the trailer for its generator during an emergency event, if not being used by the City of Waterville.

7. Agrees to hold Le Sueur County harmless from any and all claims from personal injuries or disabilities to the City of Waterville employees, or to any other person arising from, or incident to, the donation of the trailer or its use or disposition by the City of Waterville.

IV. APPROVALS

This agreement shall become effective upon the date of final signature, and will remain in effect unless modified by mutual written consent.
