

RESOLUTION ADOPTING ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE CONTINUOUS COMPLIANCE OF SUBSURFACE SEWAGE TREATMENT SYSTEMS WITHIN 350 FEET OF LAKE EMILY (MN DNR LAKE NUMBER 40012400)

WHEREAS: Minnesota Statute, Chapter 394 titled **Planning, Development, Zoning** provides counties the authority to establish official controls which shall further the purpose and objectives of a County Plan and for the purpose of promoting the health, safety, morals, and general welfare of the community;

WHEREAS: Minnesota Statutes, Chapters 115.55 and 145A.05 provide counties with authority to regulate sewage and sewage treatment systems;

WHEREAS: The 2016-2021 Le Sueur County Local Water Management Plan states “Identifying wastewater treatment as a priority in the water plan is considered a vital component for supporting existing state and local requirements”;

WHEREAS: The 2016-2021 Le Sueur County Local Water Management Plan states “All septic systems in Le Sueur County [be] brought into compliance”; and

WHEREAS: The 2016-2021 Le Sueur County Local Water Management Plan states “It has been requested of the County to investigate and address the compliance status...in and around county lake communities”; and

WHEREAS: The 2016-2021 Le Sueur County Local Water Management Plan placed Lake Emily on the Priority List for Lake Septic Inventory; and

WHEREAS: The County Board of Commissioners, following proper legal notice, held a public hearing on said ordinance; and

NOW, THEREFORE: Be it resolved that the Le Sueur County Board of Commissioners hereby adopts the “Ordinance Providing For The Continuous Compliance Of Subsurface Sewage Treatment Systems Within 350 Feet Of Lake Emily (MN DNR Lake Number 40012400)”.
