

## **Minutes of Le Sueur County Board of Commissioners Meeting January 28, 2020**

The Le Sueur County Board of Commissioners met in regular session on Tuesday, January 28, 2020 at 9:00 a.m. in the Courthouse at Le Center, Minnesota. Those members present were: Dave Gliszinski, Lance Wetzel, Steve Rohlfing and Danny O'Keefe. Also present were Darrell Pettis and Brent Christian. John King was excused.

On motion by O'Keefe seconded by Gliszinski and unanimously approved, the Board approved the agenda for the business of the day.

On motion by Wetzel, seconded by O'Keefe and unanimously approved, the Board approved the consent agenda:

- Approved the January 21, 2020 County Board Minutes and Summary Minutes.
- Approved the Application for Exempt Permit for NWTF Valley Yelpers
  - Transferred \$800,000.00 from Hometown Bank Cleveland to Cornerstone State Bank of Le Sueur for Payroll and Human Services claims.
  - Transferred \$148,628.43 from Hometown Bank Cleveland (Bond Proceeds) to First State Bank Le Center for Justice Center payment.

Joshua Mankowski, Planning & Zoning Administrator appeared before the Board with several items for approval.

On motion by Wetzel, seconded by O'Keefe and approved unanimously via roll call 4-0, the Board approved a Conditional Use Permit for MIKE & LINDA FINLEY, JANESVILLE, MN, (APPLICANT\OWNER) for an After-The-Fact Conditional Use Permit to allow the applicant grading, excavating and filling of approximately 123.35 cubic yards of material for the construction of retaining walls, pervious patio, and beach sand blanket in the shore impact zone and within the bluff in a Recreational Residential "RR" District and a Flood Fringe "FF" Floodplain Overlay District, on Lake Francis, a Recreational Development "RD" lake. Property is located in Government Lot 1, Section 34, Elysian Township. The application was approved with the Planning Commission adding following condition: Add native forbs to the rock area on each side of the project. Findings are on file at the Planning & Zoning Office.

On motion by Gliszinski, seconded by Wetzel and unanimously approved, the Board tabled the purchase of a 2020 Grand Caravan.

Cindy Westerhouse, Human Resources Director came before the Board with several items for approval.

On motion by O'Keefe, seconded by Wetzel and unanimously approved, the Board approved the recommendation to grant regular status to Ryan Frederick, full time Deputy in the Sheriff's Office, effective January 28, 2020.

On motion by Gliszinski, seconded by O'Keefe and unanimously approved, the Board approved the recommendation to grant regular status to Angie Doerr, full time Public Health Nurse in Public Health, effective January 28, 2020.
