

**Minutes of Le Sueur County Board of Commissioners Meeting  
September 21, 2021**

The Le Sueur County Board of Commissioners met in special session on Tuesday, September 21, 2021 at 7:00 p.m. in the Justice Center at Le Center, Minnesota. Those members present were: John King, Danny O’Keefe, Steve Rohlffing and Lance Wetzel. Also present were Joe Martin and Pam Herrmann.

Commissioner Rohlffing called the meeting to order.

Jason Femrite, Bolton & Menk gave an overview of the West Jefferson Sewer District.

Dani Blaschko, Auditor Treasurer gave information on the first assessment. The assessments are payable over 10 years beginning in 2022. Prepayments can be made up to December 31, 2021 interest free. The interest rate is 2.25%. Le Sueur County will be filing a lien with the Records office for anyone that has not paid by November 30, 2021. Statements will be sent in the mail next week.

On motion by Wetzel, seconded by O’Keefe and unanimously approved, the Board opened public comment.

Two comments by Jason Gibbs and David Hopkins and one online by Judy Hendley.

On motion by King, seconded by Wetzel the public comment section was closed.

On motion by King, seconded by Wetzel, the Board unanimously adopted the assessments as presented for everyone included on the Final Assessment Roll with Commissioner Rohlffing abstaining.

Dani presented on the second assessment roll which was for the non-reimbursable costs. This lien is payable over 2 years starting with taxes in 2022. Prepayments can be made up to December 31, 2021 interest free. The interest rate is 2.25%. Le Sueur County will be filing a lien with the Records office for anyone that has not paid by November 30, 2021. Statements will be sent in the mail next week. This lien runs separately from the other one.

On motion by O’Keefe seconded by King and unanimously approved, the Board opened public comment.

No public comments

On motion by Wetzel, seconded by King the public comment section was closed.

On motion by Wetzel, seconded by O’Keefe, the Board unanimously adopted the second assessments as presented for everyone on the Final Assessment Roll with Commissioner Rohlffing abstaining.
