

Minutes of Canvass Board
Tuesday, November 15, 2022

Danielle Ongie, Auditor-Treasurer, called the Canvass Board to order on Tuesday, November 15th at 1:00 p.m. in the Government Center in Le Center, Minnesota. Those members present were Commissioner John King, Le Sueur City Mayor Shawn Kirby, Megan McMonagle, District Court Administrator appointee and Dani Ongie, Auditor-Treasurer, Also present was Carol Blaschko, Election Administrator and Joe Martin, Le Sueur County Administrator.

All members of the canvass board recited the oath.

On motion by Kirby, seconded by King and approved, the Le Sueur County Canvassing Board hereby appoints Carol Blaschko, Election Administrator as the Post Election Review Official pursuant to M.S. 206.89.

Carol Blaschko presented a brief overview of the elections process and made note of any issues that came up during the election.

Election results were canvassed for the 2022 State General and County race, the abstracts were signed and will be forwarded to the Minnesota Secretary of State.

Carol Blaschko presented a brief overview of the Post-Election Equipment Review.

The precincts randomly selected by the canvass board were Cleveland Township (405 votes) and Le Center City (820 votes). The Post-Election Review of the State General Election shall be held in the Commission Chambers of the Le Sueur County Government Center at 9:00 a.m. on Monday, November 21, 2022. If additional review is necessary, it is to be held at the Government Center as well on Tuesday, November 22, 2022.

On motion by Kirby, seconded McMonagle and approved, the Canvass Board meeting was adjourned.
