## Weekly Update

**Week of 5/13/19 - 5/17/19**

Finishes were in full force this week! Wall covering began on the first floor main lobby and throughout second floor, pictured above. The decorative wood ceilings continued on the main lobby and second floor atrium partnering with the decorative wood wall that is set in the main stairwell opposite the elevator. Floor tile and base in the main lobby, security screening and corridor were set and will be grouted next week! Exterior work included mass grading around the building and parking lot islands, flag pole bases and steel canopies above the exterior doors. On the electrical side, AV equipment, such as TVs and speakers, as well as security cameras were placed throughout finished ceilings and rooms. Woodwork in the courtrooms continued with wall paneling, Judges and Jury benches and dividing walls. In the Jail, more floor sealing and acoustical sound board were completed!

Next week, the landscaper will begin with irrigation leading into planting, weather permitting. The continuation of install of finishes with wall coverings, wood ceilings and walls, electrical plates, cameras and AV equipment. Plus the final inspection and sign off on all the plumbing!
