Today Le Sueur County is adding one new lab confirmed case. The individual is 28 years old, not hospitalized with no contact with a lab confirmed case therefore considered community transmission. Also note the change in the age range of confirmed cases. MDH is now rounding ages so our oldest case was previously listed as 62; the oldest case is now listed as 63.
