❑ Recycling:

- Le Sueur County Recycling Drop-Off Sites – facility is open to Le Sueur County residents.
 - 515 South Maple Ave, Le Center (*Le Sueur County Highway Shop – Le Center*)
 - 1199 Dodd Rd, Cleveland (*Le Sueur County Highway Shop – Cleveland*)
 - Hours of Operation: Open 24 hours per day, 7 days per week
 - Accepted Recyclable Material: plastic bottles & containers (#'s 1,2,5), metal food & beverage containers, paper, flattened cardboard & paperboard, glass food & beverage containers
- City of Le Center Recycling Drop-Off Site – facility is open to City of Le Center residents.
 - 180 South Lexington Avenue, Le Center
 - Hours of Operation: Wednesdays 4:30 PM to 7:30 PM & Saturdays 7 AM to 12 PM
 - Accepted Recyclable Material: Tin & aluminum cans, glass bottles, plastic jugs, mixed paper & corrugated cardboard
- Waterville Township Recycling Drop-Off Site – facility is open to Le Sueur County residents.
 - Location: Waterville Township Hall at 419 3rd St S, Waterville
 - Hours of Operation:
 - Summer Hours (May-October): Mondays and Saturdays from 6:30 AM to 2 PM
 - Winter Hours (November-April): Mondays and Saturdays from 6:30 AM to 1 PM
 - Accepted Material: cardboard, paper, recyclable plastic, glass.

❑ Household Hazardous Waste: paints, solvents, paint thinners, batteries, and thermostats that contain mercury.

 - Open until end of October.
 - Tuesday: 12 to 6 PM
 - Wednesday and Thursday: 12 to 4 PM
 - 2nd Saturday of Each Month: 8 AM to 12:30 PM
